

## 2019/20 Falls Festival Byron Car Passes – Condition of Entry

### **BIG RIG PASS - Conditions of Entry**

*Please be aware that upon purchase of your BIG RIG PASS (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:*

1. It is a condition of Falls Festival Byron that you must pre-purchase a BIG RIG Pass to gain entry to the Falls Festival campers area at North Byron Parklands (NBP) in a private RV, Campervan (4 Berth or Larger than 6 Metres), or are driving any vehicle towing a Caravan, Trailer, Camper Trailer or any other towed device.
2. You must arrive on the day assigned on your Pass or your vehicle may be denied entry to the venue. Those planning on leaving the campgrounds earlier than Friday 03 Jan 2020 are not eligible to bring an RV, Campervan (4 Berth or Larger than 6 Metres) or enter driving any vehicle towing a Caravan, Trailer, Camper Trailer, or any other towed device.
3. Ensure that the type of Pass and the details printed on it are correct.
4. One Pass is required per vehicle. Each vehicle occupant does not require a Pass. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the festival and campgrounds.
5. This Pass allows you to enter the campgrounds in an RV, Campervan (4 Berth or Larger than 6 Metres) or in a vehicle towing a Caravan, Trailer, Camper Trailer, or any other towed device, and gives you the option to camp beside and inside your vehicle, in an allocated space. **Please note: There is a strict no vehicle movement policy for this pass. Once your vehicle is parked there is no movement allowed until Friday 03 January 2020.**
6. There is no inbound vehicle access to NBP between 6:00am – 1:00pm Friday 03 January 2020. These times are subject to change.
7. Pass is valid until 2:00pm Friday 03 January 2020 by which time all private vehicles must depart North Byron Parklands.
8. Treat your Pass like cash. Passes are sold on a strict no refund, no exchange, and no replacement basis. Passes are refunded under the relevant laws that protect the organiser, the Venue & ticket purchaser. A change in your personal plans or circumstances does not warrant a refund.
9. Your Pass must be placed on the driver's side dashboard of your vehicle.
10. The Pass should be positioned so that it is clearly visible from the exterior of the vehicle but does not obstruct the driver's vision.
11. Pass needs to be in position well before arriving at NBP as it will need to be seen by police and traffic controllers as you approach North Byron Parklands and also assists our staff in knowing where to direct your vehicle once inside the property.
12. Pass contains a barcode that will be scanned upon arrival. Do not damage or tamper with this barcode or your entry may be delayed or denied.
13. Your Pass is only applicable for private use vehicles. It is not valid for taxis, trucks, buses or commercial mini-buses.
14. Once your vehicle is parked in the approved campground area, **it is not permitted to be moved until you depart the festival.** Failure to adhere to this may result in your event & camping wristband being removed by staff as you exit.
15. The Pass does not entitle your vehicle to park in the North Byron Parklands day parking areas.
16. The Pass does not include entry to the Festival. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the venue campground must also hold a valid Falls Byron 3 Day Festival Ticket & valid Camping Ticket.
17. Passes may not, without the prior written consent of Falls Festival, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and

trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If a Pass is sold or used in breach of this condition, the bearer of the ticket will be refused admission.

18. Passes are non-exchangeable and non-refundable.
19. Upon entering the Venue, it is deemed that the pass holder accepts the Pass Conditions of Entry and vehicles are parked at your own risk.
20. Any vehicle causing delays to the free movement of vehicles into the campgrounds may result in that vehicle and its occupants being refused entry to the campgrounds and the Festival.
21. In addition to the full list of banned items listed on the Falls Festival website, the following items are banned from entering the venue and its campgrounds: No Butane Gas Cylinders, No Gas Bottles (External to purpose built RVs & caravans), No Fuels or Flammable Liquids, No Gas Cookers or Lanterns.
22. Falls Festival, except to the extent required by law, will not accept liability for any accidents, damage or loss incurred whilst the vehicle is at the Venue.
23. Redemption not available on this Pass.

### **CAMPING WITH CAR PASS - Conditions of Entry**

*Please be aware that upon purchase of your CAMPING WITH CAR PASS (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:*

1. It is a condition of Falls Festival Byron that you must pre-purchase a CAMPING WITH CAR Pass to gain entry to the Falls Festival campers area at North Byron Parklands (NBP) in a private vehicle. This includes hire vehicles and utilities. Two-wheeled motorbikes (without a sidecar) do not require a pass, although they are subject to all other conditions and/or restrictions relating to vehicle movements.
2. You must arrive on the day assigned on your Pass or your vehicle may be denied entry to the venue. Those planning on leaving the campgrounds earlier than Friday 03 January 2020 are not eligible to camp with their car.
3. Ensure that the type of Pass and the details printed on it are correct.
4. One Pass is required per vehicle. Each vehicle occupant does not require a Pass. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the festival and campgrounds.
5. This Pass allows you to camp beside your vehicle, in an allocated space. **Please note: There is a strict no vehicle movement policy for this pass. Once your vehicle is parked there is no movement allowed until Friday 03 January 2020.**
6. There is no inbound vehicle access to NBP between 6:00am – 1:00pm Friday 03 January 2020. These times are subject to change.
7. Pass is valid until 2:00pm Friday 03 January 2020 by which time all private vehicles must depart North Byron Parklands.
8. Treat your Pass like cash. Passes are sold on a strict no refund, no exchange, and no replacement basis. Passes are refunded under the relevant laws that protect the organiser, the Venue & ticket purchaser. A change in your personal plans or circumstances does not warrant a refund.
9. Your Pass must be placed on the driver's side dashboard of your vehicle.
10. The Pass should be positioned so that it is clearly visible from the exterior of the car but does not obstruct the driver's vision.

15. The Pass does not entitle your vehicle to park in the North Byron Parklands day parking areas.
16. The Pass does not include entry to the Festival. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the venue campground must also hold a valid Falls Byron 3 Day Festival Ticket & valid Camping Ticket.
17. Passes may not, without the prior written consent of Falls Festival, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If a Pass is sold or used in breach of this condition, the bearer of the ticket will be refused admission.

#### **CAMPING WITHOUT CAR PASS - Conditions of Entry**

*Please be aware that upon purchase of your CAMPING WITHOUT CAR PASS (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:*

1. It is a condition of Falls Festival Byron that you must pre-purchase a CAMPING WITHOUT CAR Pass to gain entry to the Falls Festival campers parking area at North Byron Parklands (NBP) in a private vehicle. This includes hire vehicles and utilities. Two-wheeled motorbikes (without a sidecar) do not require a pass, although they are subject to all other conditions and/or restrictions relating to vehicle movements.
2. You must arrive on the day assigned on your Pass or your vehicle may be denied entry to the venue.
3. Ensure that the type of Pass and the details printed on it are correct.
4. One Pass is required per vehicle. Each vehicle occupant does not require a Pass. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the festival and campgrounds.
5. There is no inbound vehicle access to NBP between 6:00am – 1:00pm Friday 03 January 2020. These times are subject to change.
6. Pass is valid until 2:00pm Friday 03 January 2020 by which time all private vehicles must depart North Byron Parklands.

15. The Pass does not include entry to the Festival. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the venue campground must also hold a valid Falls Byron 3 Day Festival Ticket & valid Camping Ticket .
16. Passes may not, without the prior written consent of Falls Festival, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If a Pass is sold or used in breach of this condition, the bearer of the ticket will be refused admission.
17. Passes are non-exchangeable and non-refundable.

#### **DAY PARKING CAR PASS - Conditions of Entry**

*Please be aware that upon purchase of your Day Parking Car Pass (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:*

1. It is a condition of Falls Festival Byron that you must pre-purchase a DAY PARKING CAR PASS to gain access to the North Byron Parklands (NBP) car park in a private vehicle. This includes rental vehicles.
2. Passes are required per day for entry to the NBP Day Car Park. Separate daily Passes will be required for entry on Monday 30 December 2019, Tuesday 31 December 2019, Wednesday 01 and Thursday 02 January 2020. No entry to Day Car Park prior to these dates.
3. Day Car Park hours of operation are 9:00am-2:00am Monday 30 December 2019 and Tuesday 31 December 2019, 9:00am-1:30am Wednesday 01 January 2020 and 9:00am-1:00am Thursday 02 January 2020.
4. There is no inbound vehicle access to NBP between 6:00am – 1:00pm Friday 03 January 2020. These times are subject to change.
5. Vehicles cannot be left in the Day Car Park overnight and sleeping in vehicles in the Day Car Park is not allowed. If you plan to drink alcohol, please organise a designated driver or catch a bus instead.
6. Vehicles not displaying a valid Pass will be refused entry to the Day Car Park.
7. Ensure that you have the correct type of Pass.
8. Pass applies to one vehicle only. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the carpark and the festival.
9. Pass is valid during the Day Car Park hours of operation for the day specified on the Pass. At the end of each day specified on the Pass all private vehicles must depart the NBP Day Car Park or

further parking fees will apply.

10. Treat your Pass like cash. Passes are sold on a strict no refund, no exchange, and no replacement basis. Passes are refunded under the relevant laws that protect the organiser, the Venue & ticket purchaser. A change in your personal plans or circumstances does not warrant a refund.
11. Your Pass must be placed on the driver's side dashboard of your vehicle.
12. The Pass should be positioned so that it is clearly visible from the exterior of the car but does not obstruct the driver's vision of traffic.
13. Pass needs to be in position well before arriving at NBP as it will need to be seen by traffic controllers as you approach North Byron Parklands, and also needs to be checked by our staff when you arrive at the Venue Day Car Park.
14. The Pass contains a barcode that will be scanned upon arrival. Do not damage or tamper with this barcode or your entry may be delayed or denied.
15. Your Pass is only applicable for private use vehicles. It is not valid for taxis, trucks, buses or commercial mini-buses.
16. Pass does not include entry to the Festival. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the NBP Day Car Park must also hold a valid Falls Festival Event ticket.
17. Pass may not, without the prior written consent of Falls Festival, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If a pass is sold or used in breach of this condition, the bearer of the ticket will be refused admission.
18. Passes are non-exchangeable and non-refundable.
19. Upon entering the venue, it is deemed that the Pass holder accepts the Pass Conditions of Entry and vehicles are parked at the Pass holders own risk.
20. Any vehicle causing delays to the free movement of vehicles into the car park may result in that vehicle and its occupants being refused entry to the car park and the Festival.
21. In addition to the full list of banned items listed on the Falls Festival website, the following items are banned from entering the venue and its Day Car Park: No Butane Gas Cylinders, No Gas Bottles (External to purpose built RVs & caravans), No Flammable Liquids or Fuel in containers, No Gas Cookers and Lanterns.
22. Falls Festival, except to the extent required by law, will not accept liability for any accidents, damage or loss incurred whilst the vehicle is at the Venue.
23. The Day Car Park is an Alcohol Free zone.
24. Redemption not available on the Pass.
